

Joan Mills

Presented with Life Membership of Kent Netball in September 1999.

- 1960 Formed Sevenoaks Netball club
- 1962 Joined the Tunbridge Wells & District Netball League Committee and was Chair for approximately 20 years (now named the Tonbridge Netball League)
- 1968 Appointed to the Kent County Netball Association Committee and was Chair for approximately 15 years
- 1975 Founder member of Chislehurst Netball Club
- 1980's (for approximately 8 years) responsible for the organisation and delivery of the Inter County Netball Tournament on behalf of England Netball – a competition involving approximately 100 teams and 1000+ athletes at senior and under 21 level. This included sourcing the venue, facilities, workforce, catering and athlete accommodation.
- 1985 Awarded the Torch Trust Trophy
- 1993 Appointed Vice Chairman of England Netball
- 1995 Joint Head of Support Services at the Netball World Championship held in Birmingham at the National Indoor Arena. Joan and her colleague were responsible for all aspects of the Championship that was non-field of play related.
- 1996 Appointed Chairman of England Netball resigned in 2001
- 2001 England Netball Team Manager and toured Australia and New Zealand with the squad, which gave Joan an excellent insight into the 'other side' of the sport in preparation for the 2002 Commonwealth Games,
- 2002 Netball Competition Manager at the Commonwealth Games held in Manchester at the, then, MEN Arena. 10 countries participated and the medal matches attracted an audience of 10,000 Joan had overall responsibility for the Netball competition, all field of play activities, technical officials, paid and volunteer workforce, working closely with the 2002 management company.
- 2013 Appointed International Technical Delegate for the 2013 World Youth Netball Championship held in Glasgow. Joan supported Netball Scotland and Glasgow Life from the time they were appointed hosts through to the completion of the championship.
- 2013 Appointed International Technical Delegate for the 2014 Commonwealth Games held in Glasgow. Joan supported the work of the Netball Competition Manager, attended regular meetings with the Director of Sport and Cluster Manager and was involved with the International Netball Federation in various discussions and meetings relating to changes to agreed procedures with Glasgow2014. Duties included Competition Planning, Technical Officials, Equipment, Venue design, Transport, timing, scoring and results and Broadcasting. Sports presentation and entertaining. Doping Control. Supporting the Umpiring Appointments Panel and Technical Officials. She was also Chair of the Appeals Committee.
